"A blue 2010 Kenworth semi-truck that was going westbound on 54 ran a red light and struck a 2001 silver Ford Taurus four-door that was going southbound on Western with a green light." McClurg added the driver of the Taurus, a 76-year-old female, was transported to Southwest Medical Center as a result of her injuries.
