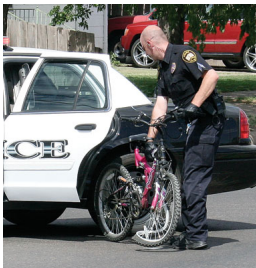


Collision injures cyclist
