With the increase in mill levies at all local governmental entities, property owners will see higher mill levies on their tax statements

Adding up the 11.035 mill increase, a home worth \$100,000 will pay an additional **\$12674** in property taxes.*

*Increase represents a home in Liberal. Those in the outside city limits will not pay city tax.

Where do my PROPERTY TAX DOLLARS go?

All our being reported on the tax bill for the year that ends the year increase was 11.035 mills, or 1.1 percent.
