What is rime?

- Encyclopedia Britannica

Rime is white, opaque, granular deposits of ice crystals formed on objects that are at a temperature below the freezing point.

Rime occurs when supercooled water droplets (at a temperature lower than 0° C [32° F]) in fog come in contact with a surface that is also at a temperature below freezing; the droplets are so small that they freeze almost immediately upon contact with the object.
