

Wadley noted it took all the units approximately an hour to contain and completely extinguish the fire, and he estimated between two and three acres were burned.

"The cause of the fire is undetermined, but fire officials do know the fire began on the south side of the roadway of Highway 54," Wadley noted. "Firefighters had to deal with 15- to 20-mph winds along with warm and dry temperatures.

Wadley added that no injuries were reported and no homes were damaged.

"It's important to remember that conditions in our area are still very dry and very favorable for fast spreading fires," Wadley concluded. "Extreme caution should be used at all times."
