The offense is a clear indication of why consistency is important. Britton Abbott and Trenton Hammond have been playing pitch and catch since seventh grade, and the two know what to expect from the other.

On one touchdown pass, Abbott looked to the flat and saw Hammond but did not make the pass. Instead, the defender moved in, and Hammond went deep, and that is when Abbott made the toss, a 53-yard scoring play that takes more than drawing something up on the chalkboard. Both player shave to know what to expect, and they did.

The passing attack has been lethal in the first two games, and before the naysayers start talking down the competition, Ulysses knocked off Great Bend Friday, 21-14. Liberal was able to chalk up 628 yard of offense against the Ulysses Tigers and 56 points.

There is no question Hays will be a different opponent Friday, but compared to last season, Liberal will be different, too.

The high-octane offense hit its stride. Liberal has more than 1,000 yards of offense in the first two weeks of the season.

Rex Heronemus was able to add some muscle to the running game, and that, coupled with a passing attack will put pressure on defenses to pick their poison.

As far as the Redskin defense, they pitched a shutout Friday and kept the Guymon Tigers to only 71 yards for the entire game.
