

The Kismet Public Library Board of Trustees will host its annual spaghetti dinner on Friday, Feb. 25. The dinner will be served from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. at the Kismet Pavilion on Main Street in Kismet. A free will donation will be accepted. Proceeds from the dinner will benefit the building fund at the library. The menu for the dinner includes the following: spaghetti and meat sauce, tossed garden salad, buttered bread and dessert.
