This is the first time since the second quarter of 2011 that the number of people working in the state has increased. The report also shows that the number of people working in the state is now higher than it was in the third quarter of 2011.

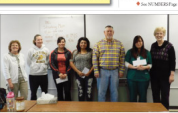
