Coroner determines Bobby died Sunday of cardiac arrest
Bobby's death was ruled a natural death. The coroner's office received a call from the police on Sunday, June 3, at 11:15 a.m. Bobby was found in his room at the Salem Hotel. He was 34 years old. The coroner's office conducted an autopsy on Bobby on Sunday, June 3. The autopsy revealed that Bobby died of a sudden cardiac arrest. Bobby had no known medical conditions. The coroner's office is currently reviewing the case. Bobby's family is being notified of the results of the autopsy.
