USDA issues recall of ground beef at Liberal's National Beef

Recall involves 22,737 lbs. of raw ground beef

Recall involves 22,737 lbs. of raw ground beef

USDA announced today that it is recalling 22,737 pounds of raw ground beef from Liberal's National Beef, a company based in Liberal, Mo. The recall is due to a possible contamination with E. coli O157:H7.

The recall involves ground beef produced between Oct. 15 and Oct. 22, 2012, at the Liberal, Mo. processing plant. The ground beef was sold under the Liberal's National Beef brand name.

USDA is asking consumers to check their freezers for any of the recalled ground beef. If found, consumers should discard the beef or cook it to 160 degrees Fahrenheit.
