Wildfires force Boy Scouts from Spanish Peaks

A 3-2 vote Monday gave Cheyenne County the authority to buy local property for a new facility at Spanish Peaks. The vote was taken after a long process of planning and fundraising. The new facility will be a 100,000-sq-ft building that will house the Boy Scouts of America's regional office. The county board voted to purchase the property from the current owner, who is offering it for sale. The purchase price is \$1.5 million. The county board also approved a plan to raise the money to buy the property. The plan is to issue bonds and to receive donations from the community. The new facility is expected to be completed in 2015.
