A 3-2 vote Monday gave Clear Fork County a measure that would allow the county to purchase the Spanish Peaks area, which is currently owned by the Boy Scouts of America. The measure was passed by a 3-2 vote in the county board meeting Monday night. The board members who voted in favor of the measure were Board Members 1, 2 and 3. Board Members 4 and 5 voted against the measure. Board Member 6 did not vote. The measure would allow the county to purchase the Spanish Peaks area for \$10 million.
