MCADD a silent killer for many

A 14-month-old boy, looking healthy and happy, looked like any other baby. But his parents, Colleen and Morgan, knew that only knew after his death, he was a perfect angel from death.

Colleen and Morgan knew in 2011 that their son, Luca, was not eating well. They noticed he was losing weight and was not growing. They took him to the pediatrician, who ran a routine blood test. The results showed that Luca had a rare genetic condition called medium-chain acyl-CoA dehydrogenase deficiency (MCADD). The doctor told them that Luca had a 1-in-10,000 chance of dying from the condition.
