Common questions about day care facilities

COLUMBUS, Ohio (AP) — A new study says that day care facilities are not always as safe as they seem. The study, published in the journal Pediatrics, found that 10 percent of day care facilities had serious safety issues, such as missing fire exits, blocked fire exits, and missing fire extinguishers. The study also found that 20 percent of facilities had missing or expired fire extinguishers, and 15 percent had missing or expired fire alarms. The study was conducted by researchers from the University of Cincinnati and the University of South Florida. The researchers visited 100 day care facilities in Ohio and Florida. They found that the most common safety issues were missing fire exits, blocked fire exits, and missing fire extinguishers. The researchers also found that many facilities did not have proper fire drills or fire escape plans. The study highlights the need for better regulation and oversight of day care facilities to ensure the safety of children.
