### Common questions about day care facilities

Parents often have questions about day care facilities. Here are some common questions and answers.

**Q: How do I choose a day care facility?**  
A: Look for a facility that is licensed and inspected by the state. Check the facility's reputation and ask for references. Visit the facility and observe the staff and children.

**Q: What should I look for in a day care facility?**  
A: Look for a facility that has a safe and secure environment. The staff should be trained and qualified. The facility should have a clear policy on discipline and health and safety.

**Q: How do I know if a day care facility is safe?**  
A: Ask for a tour of the facility and observe the staff and children. Check the facility's license and inspection records. Ask for references from other parents.
