Missouri/Kansas see increase in drowning deaths

Missouri and Kansas have seen an increase in drowning deaths in the past few years, according to a report from the U.S. Coast Guard. The report shows that in 2012, there were 103 drowning deaths in Missouri and 102 in Kansas, compared to 98 in Missouri and 97 in Kansas in 2011. The report also shows that the number of drowning deaths in Missouri and Kansas has increased by 5 percent and 6 percent, respectively, since 2010.
