Missouri and Kansas have seen an increase in drowning deaths over the past few years, according to a report from the U.S. Coast Guard. The report shows that in 2012, there were 103 drowning deaths in Missouri and 102 in Kansas, compared to 98 in Missouri and 97 in Kansas in 2011. The report also shows that the majority of drowning deaths occurred in swimming pools and hot tubs.

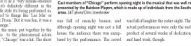
