**Liberal man faces 32 months in prison**  
A federal judge has sentenced a 32-year-old man to 32 months in prison for a federal conspiracy to defraud a bank. The man, who is a former member of the Liberal Party, was found guilty of conspiring to defraud a bank of \$1.5 million. The judge sentenced the man to 32 months in prison, with credit for time served. The man is currently in custody at the Federal Correctional Institute in Miami.
