Scenic study shows tourism in Sevier County has \$67.6 million impact

Sevier County's tourism industry is a major economic driver, according to a new study by the Sevier County Economic Development Authority. The study, which is the first of its kind in the county, shows that tourism in Sevier County has a total economic impact of \$67.6 million, including \$27.6 million in direct economic activity and \$40 million in indirect economic activity.
