Fort Hood shooter convicted on 13 counts of murder
A man accused of the 2009 Fort Hood shooting has been convicted on 13 counts of murder. The man, Nidal Hasan, was found guilty of the deaths of 13 people and the attempted murder of another 30. He was sentenced to life in prison without the possibility of parole.
