KBI investigating incident involving Kansas sheriff
TOPEKA, Kan. — The Kansas Bureau of Investigation is investigating an incident involving a Topeka sheriff and a KBI agent. The incident occurred on September 17, 2013, at the Topeka Sheriff's Office. The KBI agent was visiting the sheriff's office to discuss a matter. The sheriff, however, became agitated and threatened the KBI agent. The KBI agent was unharmed and was able to leave the office. The KBI is currently investigating the incident and has not yet made any charges. The sheriff has been placed on administrative leave.

Hutchinson regional hospital settles federal allegations of Medicare false claims
HUTCHINSON, Kan. — Hutchinson Regional Medical Center has settled federal allegations of Medicare false claims. The settlement was reached after the hospital was investigated by the U.S. Department of Justice. The allegations were that the hospital had submitted false claims to Medicare. The settlement amount was \$1.5 million. The hospital has agreed to implement new procedures to prevent such claims in the future. The settlement is effective as of September 18, 2013.

Topeka expands anti-discrimination ordinance
TOPEKA, Kan. — The Topeka City Council has expanded its anti-discrimination ordinance. The new ordinance now includes protection for sexual orientation and gender identity. The ordinance prohibits discrimination in employment, housing, and public accommodations. The ordinance also prohibits harassment based on sexual orientation and gender identity. The ordinance was passed by a vote of 7-2 on September 17, 2013. The ordinance is effective as of September 18, 2013.

Kan. Salvation Army heads to Colorado
