COMMENTS: Sydney (AP) — A fire broke out on board a Qantas Boeing 747-400 en route to Sydney, Australia, on Tuesday, Sept. 24, 2013. The aircraft landed safely in Sydney, Australia, and all 370 passengers and crew members were evacuated. The fire was contained to the cargo hold and did not affect the flight.
