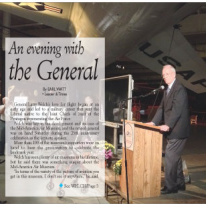

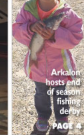
### Vision Team hopes for more community input

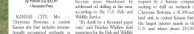
