Government reopens after Congress ends 16-day shutdown



Government reopens after Congress ends 16-day shutdown
The federal government has resumed operations after a 16-day shutdown. The shutdown was caused by a disagreement between the House and the Senate over the budget. The House passed a budget that would have cut funding for many federal agencies, while the Senate passed a budget that would have kept funding at current levels. The two budgets were not reconciled, and the government was forced to shut down. The shutdown ended on Oct. 17, 2013, when the House and Senate agreed on a temporary funding bill. The government is now back to work, but the budget dispute remains unresolved.
