Washington, D.C. (AP) — The United States' top diplomat in Africa, Samantha Power, said she was "in awe" of the resilience of the people of the Democratic Republic of Congo. Power, who has been in the region for nearly a year, said she was struck by the courage of the Congolese people, who have endured decades of conflict and violence. She praised the leadership of President Joseph Kabila and the efforts of the Congolese government to bring about a peaceful resolution to the conflict. Power also praised the work of the United Nations and the international community in supporting the Congolese people.
