**Who needs Bluetooth headsets? Motorola patents 'neck tattoo' smartphone accessory**  
A person's neck could be the next frontier for mobile devices, according to a new patent filed by Motorola. The patent, titled "Neck tattoo," describes a device that would be attached to a person's neck and used to interact with a smartphone. The device would be made of a flexible material and would be able to bend and stretch with the neck.
