Study: US spewing 50% more methane than EPA says
A new study from the University of Colorado Boulder shows that the United States is spewing 50% more methane than the EPA has estimated. The study, published in the journal *Environmental Science and Technology*, found that methane emissions from the oil and gas sector are significantly higher than previously reported. The researchers used a combination of satellite data and ground-based measurements to estimate methane emissions. The findings suggest that methane emissions are a much larger climate change concern than previously thought.
