**Emphasize safety
when decorating
for the holidays**
LIBERTON — The holiday season is a time of joy and celebration, but it's also a time when safety should be a top priority. The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) reports that the majority of home fires during the holidays are caused by candles, and that the majority of those fires occur in bedrooms and living rooms. To help prevent these fires, the NFPA offers the following tips:
• Use candles in a safe manner. Place candles on a stable, non-flammable surface. Never leave a candle unattended. Extinguish candles when you leave the room or go to bed.
• Use flameless candles. Flameless candles are a safer alternative to real candles. They look like real candles but don't have a flame, so they can't catch fire.
• Use string lights safely. Check string lights for frayed wires and loose connections. Don't overload outlets. Don't use string lights outdoors if they aren't rated for outdoor use.
• Use Christmas trees safely. Use a real tree if possible. If you use a real tree, water it daily to keep it from drying out. Don't use a real tree if it's dry. If you use an artificial tree, make sure it's properly secured to the wall. Don't use an artificial tree if it's not labeled as fire-retardant.
• Use Christmas lights safely. Check lights for frayed wires and loose connections. Don't overload outlets. Don't use lights outdoors if they aren't rated for outdoor use.
