**Emphasize safety

To help prevent these fires, the NFPA offers the following tips:
• Use candles in a safe manner. Never leave a lit candle unattended. Place candles in sturdy, non-flammable holders. Keep candles away from flammable decorations, curtains, and furniture.
• Use caution with electrical decorations. Check for frayed wires and loose connections. Do not overload electrical outlets. Use outdoor-rated decorations for outdoor use.
• Be careful with decorations. Avoid hanging decorations from ceilings or other overhead surfaces. Use ladders safely when decorating.
• Turn off decorations when leaving the house or going to bed.
• Have a fire escape plan. Practice fire drills with your family. Know how to use a fire extinguisher.
• Call 911 if you have a fire. Do not attempt to fight a fire that is out of control.
