Asian nations dominate international test

WASHINGTON (AP) — Asian nations dominated an international test of 11-year-olds' math skills on Tuesday, with Singapore and South Korea leading the pack. The United States ranked 25th out of 40 countries.

The test, known as the Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study, was administered by the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development. It is the largest and most comprehensive international assessment of students' math and science skills.

Singapore scored the highest, followed by South Korea, Hong Kong, and Japan. The United States scored lower than most other nations, with only Mexico and the Dominican Republic performing worse.

The test results are expected to influence education policy in many countries, as they provide a benchmark for how well students are performing in math and science.
