Asian nations dominate international test

WASHINGTON, D.C. (AP) — Asian nations dominated an international test of 11-year-olds' math skills, with South Korea and Singapore leading the pack. The results of the Progress in International Reading and Literacy Study (PIRLS) were announced Tuesday.

The study, which is the largest and most comprehensive of its kind, tested 515,000 students in 45 countries. South Korea scored highest, followed by Singapore, Finland, and the Netherlands. The United States ranked 23rd.

The test measured students' ability to understand and use written language. It included questions on reading comprehension, mathematics, and science.
