County looks to spend \$100K to stop concealed carry in 2 buildings

Commission may request 4-year exemption from concealed carry law before spending on security

The Board of Supervisors is set to vote on a resolution that would request a four-year exemption from the state's concealed carry law for two buildings in Seward County. The exemption would allow the county to spend up to \$100,000 on security measures for the buildings during that period. The buildings in question are the Seward County Courthouse and the Seward County Jail. The exemption is necessary because the state law prohibits local governments from imposing their own security measures on these buildings. The Board of Supervisors is expected to vote on the resolution on Monday, December 16, 2013.
