### Sen. Moran calls on OSHA to stop unlawful regulation of family farms

Lawrence, Kan. — Sen. Roy Blunt (R-Kan.) today called on the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) to stop what he says is an unlawful and burdensome regulation of family farms. He said the regulation would force farms to spend thousands of dollars on safety equipment and training, even though the risks of farming are low. Blunt said he will introduce legislation to repeal the regulation.
