**Optima, Okla., awarded REAP Grant to rehabilitate water well**  
Optima, Okla., has been awarded a REAP Grant to rehabilitate a water well. The grant is for \$100,000 and will be used to pay for the cost of the well rehabilitation. The well is located on the town's main street and is used to provide water to the town's residents. The well was installed in 1950 and is now in need of rehabilitation. The town's water utility is responsible for the well's maintenance and rehabilitation.
