Massive pileup on I-94 kills 3, more than 20 hurt

A massive pileup of vehicles on Interstate 94 (I-94) in Oklahoma City on Wednesday morning resulted in three deaths and more than 20 injuries. The crash occurred on the eastbound side of I-94, near the intersection with 15th Street. The vehicles involved in the crash were traveling at high speeds. The crash caused a major traffic jam on the highway for several hours. Emergency responders arrived at the scene quickly and began providing medical aid to the injured.
