**Kan. high court upholds Hugoton homicide verdict**

**CMT Announces Randy Hines, Lee Bryn, Susan Corbin, Hill, Briggs & The Builders to present out state-stadium lineup**

WICHITA, Kan. (AP) — The Kansas Supreme Court has upheld the homicide verdict against a man accused of shooting a teenage girl in a parking lot in Hugoton, Kan., in 2007.

The court's decision in *State v. Hines* is the latest in a series of rulings that have upheld the state's "stand-your-ground" law, which allows a person to use deadly force if they believe it is necessary to protect themselves or others.

Hines, 34, was charged with first-degree murder after the shooting. He was found guilty of second-degree murder and sentenced to life in prison without parole.

The state's attorney general, Karyn Pryor, had asked the court to overturn the verdict, arguing that the stand-your-ground law did not apply in this case.

The court, in a 4-3 decision, ruled that the law did apply and that the jury's verdict was supported by the evidence.

**Gun fight: Smith & Wesson, Ruger quit California over stamping requirement**



WICHITA, Kan. (AP) — Two major gun manufacturers, Smith & Wesson and Ruger, have announced they are leaving California because of a new stamping requirement.

The requirement, which took effect in January, mandates that all firearms sold in the state must have a specific stamp on the receiver.

Smith & Wesson and Ruger argued that the requirement was too costly and would significantly impact their ability to do business in the state.

WICHITA, Kan. (AP) — The state's attorney general, Karyn Pryor, has announced that she will appeal the court's decision in *State v. Hines*.

Pryor's office filed a notice of appeal with the court, arguing that the stand-your-ground law should not apply in this case.

The appeal is expected to be heard by the court in the coming months.
