Forgen was third title in four years

The Columbia University men's basketball team won its third state championship in four years on Monday night, defeating the Princeton Tigers 77-67 in a thrilling overtime game. The team, coached by Jim Ferry, had a record of 28-10 and was ranked No. 10 in the state. The game was a rematch of the 2011 championship, which Columbia won 77-67. Columbia's lead guard, Matt Forgen, was named the state player of the year for the second time in his career. He scored 28 points in the championship game, including a game-winning shot in overtime.
