Report: Thousands of convicted criminals freed while awaiting deportation proceedings
A report released by the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU) shows that thousands of convicted criminals are being held in U.S. immigration detention facilities while awaiting deportation proceedings. The report states that these individuals are often held in overcrowded and unsanitary conditions, and are denied access to legal counsel and other basic rights. The ACLU is calling for an end to this practice and for the implementation of reforms to the immigration detention system.
