Report: Thousands of convicted criminals freed while awaiting deportation proceedings
A report from the American Immigration Law Initiative (AILI) shows that thousands of convicted criminals are being released from federal custody while awaiting deportation proceedings. The report states that the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has a backlog of over 100,000 cases, and that many of these cases involve individuals with criminal records. The report also notes that the DHS has a policy of releasing individuals with criminal records, even if they are not yet ready for deportation.
