For mill levy increase
The Board of Trustees of the University of Maryland System has approved a plan to raise the state mill levy from 1.0 to 1.1 percent, effective July 1, 2015. The plan also includes a 10-cent increase in the state sales tax on alcohol and tobacco products, and a 10-cent increase in the state sales tax on motor vehicles. The plan is expected to generate an additional \$1.5 billion in revenue for the state.
